

SOUTH RIVER PARK CITIZEN ASSOCIATION FACILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS (Effective June 1, 2005)

Section 1. SRPCA Rules and Regulations

These Rules and Regulations are enacted and apply to any circumstances when members and/or non-member guests use South River Park Association ("SRPCA") facilities and all parties acknowledge and agree to be bound thereby.

Section 2. Regulations

- A. No person shall violate any regulation posted for the operation of an individual SRPCA facility.
- B. No person or permit holder shall violate any rule or condition on permit.
- C. All teen/children events must be chaperoned by parents of the participants and by the person who signed the contract.
- D. All events must end by **12:30 AM** and the clubhouse cleaned and locked by **1:00 AM**. Other arrangement may be made on a case-by-case basis with permission of the clubhouse committee.
- E. General Facility Use:
 - i. **Electric** – The only breakers that need to be turned on and off are the Men and Women's bathroom and gable fan. Please do not touch any other breakers.
 - ii. **Tables and Chairs** – Tables and chairs are available for your event. These must be set up and taken down by you. Please wipe down and clean the tables and chairs after your event.
 - iii. **Bathrooms** – The Men and Women's bathrooms are supplied with the necessary paper products. Please clean the bathrooms and *re-stock paper products* after your event.

Section 3. Alcohol/Tobacco, Controlled Substances

Possession, use or distribution of illegal drugs or controlled dangerous substances is prohibited. Smoking is prohibited inside the clubhouse structure but is permitted outside the clubhouse. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are permitted at teen/children parties.

Section 4. Indecent Conduct

- A. Urinating or defecating on SRPCA property other than in places officially provided is prohibited.
- B. No person shall engage in the act of sexual intercourse or other sexual act or indecent or obscene acts or sexual harassment on SRPCA property.

Section 5. Obstructing Entrances, Exits, Sidewalks

No person(s) shall congregate or assemble in or about any public structure on SRPCA property in such a manner as to hinder or obstruct the proper use thereof.

Section 6. Employees: Interference with Duties and Programs

- A. No person may interfere with any SRPCA members or designees acting in the course of his or her official duties.
- B. No person may disrupt or obstruct participation in a SRPCA program, activity or at a SRPCA facility.

Section 7. Unauthorized Presence

A person requested to leave SRPCA property by authorized personnel must do so immediately or be subject to arrest by County public safety officials.

Section 8. Destruction of Park Property

- A. No person may deface, destroy, injure, misuse, or remove any SRPCA property.
- B. Clubhouse and grounds must be restored to their initial condition. All trash must be removed from the clubhouse grounds at the end of the event by the person holding the event.

Section 9. Littering, Dumping and Storage

- A. No person may deposit, leave, or spill refuse or other substances on SRPCA property other than in receptacles provided for this purpose.
- B. No person may deposit refuse from private premises in SRPCA trash receptacles.
- C. No person may store material of any description on Park property except by written authorization from the President or Vice President.

Section 10. Posting Notices, Carrying Signs and Picketing

Attaching or posting of notices, signs, or any other objects on SRPCA property is prohibited except by permit. Carrying signs or picketing on SRPCA property is prohibited except by permit, which permit may be expressly denied in the sole discretion of the SRPCA.

Section 11. Erecting Structures

Enclosure of any area or erection of any structures on SRPCA property is prohibited unless authorized by SRPCA permit.

Section 12. Commercial Use

Solicitation of any business, trade or occupation is strictly prohibited unless authorized by permit. This includes conducting class instruction for a fee and the taking of photographs and/or videos for commercial use.

Section 13. Audio Devices and Noise

No person may play an audio device or create noise as to disturb the peace. Music volume and noise level must be kept at a minimum.

Section 14. Automobile Service

No person may service any automobile on Park property. Prohibited activities include washing, repairing, or performing other work, except in case of an emergency or by SRPCA permit.

Section 15. Powered Model Airplanes and Rockets

No powered model airplanes or rockets shall be flown or launched from any Park area except on officially designated areas or by SRPCA permit.

Section 16. Fireworks and Explosives

No person may possess and or discharge any fireworks or other explosive pyrotechnics on Park property, except by special SRPCA permit.

Section 17. Weapons

No person shall carry or possess or discharge a bow and arrow, dart, firearm, knife with a blade of more than three (3) inches in length, or other dangerous weapon on Park property except where permitted in designated areas. This provision does not apply to law enforcement officers and persons with legal permits.

Section 18. Gambling

No person may engage in gaming or gambling for money or any other thing in any form on SRPCA property except by written permission from the President or Vice President for charitable purposes.

Section 19. Metal Detectors, Digging

Using metal detectors and/or digging into the surface of Park property is prohibited except by permit.
